Beginner (D) classes are for riders who have not competed in any form of MX racing prior to 1 January, 2017.

Class Advancement Beginner to Novice: The Top 5 overall season finishers as well as any rider who has had 3 or more overall race finishes in any previous OSCE season must move to the next higher classification. This rule applies to the 65cc Beginner and 85cc Beginner classes as well.

Class Advancement Novice to Intermediate: Will be based on their calculated Rider Performance Value (RPV) as per the AMA Rulebook, Page 10. Section E.

Age effective date for Youth classes is 1 January of the current year. Age of all vet classes is the day of the event.

2S = 2 Stroke, 4S = 4 Stroke, WB = Wheelbase, FW = Front Wheel Maximum, RW = Rear Wheel Maximum, Inch Measurement = Max size unless stated otherwise, SS (Single Speed), MS (Multi Speed), AC (Air Cooled)

A = Expert/Pro, B = Intermediate, C = Novice, D = Beginner
